Eligibility Requirements

Applicant must be a student at the Eveleth/Gilbert Senior High School or be home schooled high school student in the area of Independent School District #2154, or reside in the area of Independent School District #2154 and attend the East Range Academy of Technology and Science as a high school student.

Qualified Institutions and Level of Study

Award may be used for:

- Full-time study
- Freshman year only
- Any post-secondary institution
- Vocational/technical school
- Two-year college
- Four-year college

Application Requirements

This is a research project sponsored by the Eveleth Heritage Committee and the Eveleth Super 8. Research will present data in a format to be determined by student and Eveleth Heritage Committee contact. Research should be for a selected period of time as noted on the attached guideline and cover from two to four locations.

Applicant must list each research location where research was conducted and materials researched.

Research report should identify and, if possible, clarify any conflicts in information.

Applicant may apply each year in attendance at high school. Applicants may receive a scholarship for each year in attendance at high school to a maximum of three scholarship awards.

Other application requirements:

Applicant's name/address/parent name/telephone number/GPA and, if a senior, the name of the intended college must appear on the first page of the report.

Applicant must include at least two (2) Student Performance Rating and Recommendation forms, as well as a statement of review by the applicant's English or Social Studies instructor or another English or Social Studies instructor from the school.

Prior to start of the research, student and Eveleth Heritage Committee contact person will agree on focus and area of research. As part of a screening process, applicants may be asked to meet with several members of the Eveleth Heritage

Committee in advance of acceptance of the research project. Applications not approved by the Eveleth Heritage Committee may not be accepted.

Final data report will be given directly to the Eveleth Heritage Committee contact person.

Additional Information:

Research data become the property of the Eveleth Heritage Committee and may be printed/published at the discretion of the Eveleth Heritage Committee.
